He won the Edgar Allan Poe Award for Best Fact Crime for *Tinseltown: Murder, Morphine and Madness at the Dawn of Hollywood*, and the Lambda Literary Award for Biography for *Wisecracker: The Life and Times of William Haines*. He is also the author of *The Contender: The Story of Marlon Brando* and *Kate: The Woman Who Was Hepburn*, named a Notable Book of the Year by the New York Times. He's written for *Architectural Digest*, *Vanity Fair*, *The New York Times*, and many other publications. He's appeared on CNN, *Turner Movie Classics*, the BBC, and various documentary series and films, including *Scotty: The Secret History of Hollywood*. His New York Times bestsellers include his books on Hepburn and Brando; *How to Be a Movie Star: Elizabeth Taylor in Hollywood*; *Hello Gorgeous: Becoming Barbra Streisand*; and *Tinseltown*. For many years, Mann was an Assistant Professor of History at Central Connecticut State University. He lives on Cape Cod, Massachusetts.
