Life of Right depicts the dramatic conflict between pro-choice and pro-life protesters in Washington, DC in the days leading up to the landmark 1992 Supreme Court decision in *Planned Parenthood v. Casey* that upheld *Roe v. Wade*. From Atlanta, Boston, Dallas, and Foley, Alabama, demonstrators descend on the nation's capital to make their voices heard by the Supreme Court. Ultimately, Justices Sandra Day O'Connor, Anthony Kennedy, and David Souter find the Due Process Clause of the 14th Amendment protects a woman's right to choose abortion.
